To be named The Courtyard, it would be a space where students can eat, work, socialise and entertain parents and visitors.

Vision designed, installed and project managed the new catering facility which included the kitchen, the servery counter and island unit. The kitchen equipment included a Hobart hood type dishwasher and several True refrigeration cabinets.
