



St Catharine's College was founded in 1473 and is situated in the centre of Cambridge. They are committed to academic excellence and success, whilst maintaining a relaxed and sociable atmosphere.

The brief for this project was to follow the design for the new Student Union at St Catharine's College which was given to Vision by the architect. Vision realised the architects initial thoughts and translated them into a physical space.

The College reclaimed an underground car park and converted this into the Student Union bar. Vision were responsible for supplying all bars and bar equipment including glasswashers and ice machines. The design also included a separate coffee area for which Vision supplied both the equipment and furniture.

The design had unique requirements for the bar and the materials which were required. Use of colour was a key feature in the architect's design and multi-coloured LED lights were used to create a feature of the bar. LED lights were also placed behind the bar to provide maximum impact.

There were several delays on site due to the overall building programme, however Vision were responsive to these delays and adjusted to the new directions given on site. Once on site, Vision installed all elements they were responsible for within 3 days.
